### **Ph.D. Detailed Advertisement**

Madhabdev University invites online applications from the eligible candidates for admission in the PhD programme 2024-25. The PhD Programme will be conducted as per the following clauses:

#### **1. Eligibility criteria for admission to Ph. D. Programme:**

**Eligibility criteria for admission to the Ph.D. Programme.**-The following are eligible to seek admission to the Ph.D. programme:

(1) Candidates who have completed:

i. A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a pointscale wherever grading system is followed.

or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

(ii) Candidates who have completed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time.

### 3. Duration of the Ph.D. Programme:

Ph.D. programme shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of six years.

4. Course work: The Course Work for M. Phil/Ph.D. programme will be mandatory. During the course work, the students are expected to meet the attendance requirements as mandated by the University.

### 5. Admission Procedure for Ph.D.:

Admission to the Ph.D. programme will be based on performance in the Madhabdev University Research Admission Test and UGC NET criteria (For those students who have qualified 2024 UGC NET examinations) and interview cum Viva. Shortlisted candidates of the MDURAT will have to make a presentation of their synopsis of a research proposal before a panel of experts for Final Selection.

### 6. Structure of MDURAT:

The entrance test will comprise of two parts –

Part A: 50 marks MCQ based on research methodology

Part B: 50 marks descriptive type (Subject Specific).

**Syllabus of MDURAT 2024 for different disciplines will be as per UGC NET Syllabus and Master Degree Syllabus of different Universities.**

The interview for PhD admissions for UGC NET qualified candidates of June 2024 shall be conducted in compliance to the University grants commission public notice No F.4-1 (UGC NET review Committee)/ 2024 (NET) 140648 dated march 27, 2024 regarding National eligibility test (NET) as Entrance test for admission to PhD Programme.

<b>For UGC NET qualified candidates</b>
<b>Category-1:</b> Award of JRF and Appointment as Assistant Professor.
<b>Category-2:</b> Appointment as Assistant Professor and admission to Ph.D.
<b>Category-3:</b> Admission to Ph.D. only

The JRF-qualified candidates may be admitted into the Ph.D. programme based on an interview as per the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022. The candidates with valid UGC Net with JRF shall be called for interview and interview shall carry 100% weightage.

UGC NET under category-2 and category-3 may be used as an entrance test for Ph.D.admission in place of entrance tests conducted by Madhabdev University for admission to Ph.D.

For candidates qualified under the category-2 and category-3, of UGC NET Examinations the marks obtained in the NET will have 70% weightage and 30% weightage will be based on the performance in the interview/viva voce conducted by the University/ HEI concerned
