Notice

It is for information to all the Undergraduate 6th Semester students (NEP 1st Batch) that with the approval of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, the guidelines concerning the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) and its progression with the Multiple Entry and Exit Options have been finalized. These guidelines are attached for information.

Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) and its progression (Guidelines)

FYUGP Programme based on NEP 2020 was adopted by Madhabdev University in the year 2022, with Multiple Entry and Exit Options based on Madhabdev University Undergraduate Regulation NEP 2020 & Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes UGC-2022

Awarding UG Certificate, UG Diploma & UG Degree

UG Certificate

Students who opt to exit after completion of the first year and have secured 40 credits will be awarded a UG certificate if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree Programme within three years and complete the degree Programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.

UG Diploma

Students who opt to exit after completion of the second year and have secured 84 credits will be awarded the UG diploma if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits. These students are allowed to re-enter within a period of three years and complete the degree Programme within the maximum period of seven years.

3-Year UG Degree

Students who wish to undergo a 3-year UG Programme will be awarded UG Degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing 128 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirement.

4-Year UG Degree (Honours)

A four-year UG Honours degree in the major discipline will be awarded to those who complete a four-year degree Programme with 174 credits and have satisfied the credit requirements.

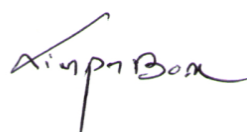
4- Year UG Degree (Honours with Research)

Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research project or dissertation in the major discipline under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College. The students, who secure 166 credits, including 8 credits from a research project/dissertation, are awarded UG Degree (Honors with Research).

Progression of Students at Madhabdev University:

After completion 3-year UG Programme the students will be awarded UG Degree in the Major discipline. The students who have completed three year UG Degree programme may enrol themselves in two year Master degree programme without opting for exit from FYUGP of Madhabdev University as the admissions are provisional and result are not declared, however he/she may opt for any other University/institution for Master Degree programme satisfying the minimum credit requirements after exit from 3 years Under Graduate Programme. The students who wants to enter in the Master Degree Programme of Madhabdev University under reservation of seats for the students graduated from Madhabdev University have to secure a minimum of **6 CGPA** without any backlog in any single paper in their 3 year Degree Programme. However the students have to appear in MDUPGET.

The students who want to pursue 4th year of the Undergraduate Programme have the option to enrol themselves into the Fourth year of a UG (Honours) degree in the major discipline providing they obtain a minimum of 6 CGPA without any backlog in any single paper in their 3 year Degree Programme.



Students who complete the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) with a Bachelor's degree with Honours without any backlog are typically eligible for direct entry into the second year of the Master's Programme, i.e., a One-Year Master's Degree Programme of Madhabdev University. However, they must appear for the Master's Degree Entrance Examination conducted by Madhabdev University.

This provision enables eligible students to complete their postgraduate degree within a reduced time frame of one year. It is important to note that this progression pathway is applicable only for students who have successfully completed the fourth year of the FYUGP with Honours from Madhabdev University.

For admission to similar Programmes at other Universities or Institutions, the decision rests solely with the respective institution.

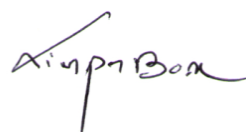
Syllabi: A one-year Master's degree Programme generally follows a condensed and intensive curriculum, concentrating on specialized areas within a discipline. It typically includes core subjects, research methodology, and, where applicable, elective courses — all delivered within a rigorous academic schedule.

At Madhabdev University, the syllabus for the fourth year of the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) and the first year of the Master's degree may be designed in alignment, ensuring academic continuity while maintaining the distinct learning outcomes and depth expected at each level of study.

Continuous formative evaluation/ Internal assessment

Total marks for each course shall be based on continuous assessments and semester-end examinations. As per the decision taken in the Academic Council, it is necessary to have a uniform pattern of 30:70 respectively for IA and Semester End theory examinations and 50:50 for IA and Semester End practical examinations.

Total Marks for each course	100%
Continuous assessment (C1)	15% marks
Continuous assessment (C2)	15% marks
Semester End Examination (C3)	70% marks.



Minimum for a Pass

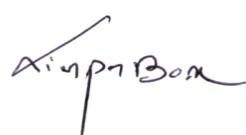
- a) No candidate shall be declared to have passed the Semester Examination as the case may be under each course/paper unless he/she obtains not less than 30% marks in written Examination /Practical Examination and 40% marks in the aggregate of written / Practical Examination and internal assessment put together in each of the courses and 40% marks (including IA) in project work and viva wherever applicable.
- b) A candidate shall be declared to have passed the program if he/she secures at least 40% of marks or a CGPA of 4.0 (Course Alpha-Sign Grade P) in the aggregate of both internal assessment and semester end examination marks put together in each unit such as Theory paper / Practical / Field work / Internship / Project work / Dissertation / Viva-voce, provided the candidate has secured not less than 30% of marks in the semester end examinations in each unit.
- c) The candidates who pass all the semester examinations in the first attempts are eligible for ranks provided they secure at least 6 CGPA.

Letter grades and Grade Points

The Letter grades and Grade Points as per UGC 10 point scale of Curriculum and credit framework for Undergraduate Programmes.

- a) Once the student has graduated and wishes to improve their marks, they will be allowed to appear for improvement examinations in any two papers of any one semester.

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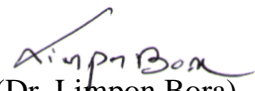
